



DOG POLICY

At Snow Farm we are happy to have people visit with their dogs. We have set a dog policy so that visiting dogs and their owners are respectful and conscientious of other users while at the facility. Please respect and adhere to these rules to continue to have the privilege of skiing or snow shoeing with you dog at Snow Farm!

Dogs are allowed to visit Snow Farm only when there is sufficient snow and re-grooming is an option. Dog paw marks expand with the sun and can result in dirt exposure and a poor skiing surface.

- Dogs are not allowed inside the Snow Farm lodge or rental area.
- Dogs allowed only on the South trails i.e., they are not permitted on the River Run or the Loop, and they must be on a lead on the Dog Loop and 2006.
- No dogs in the overnight huts.
- Please take a dog poo bag - we can supply them for free at the front desk.
- Please try to make sure that dogs do not urinate in snow banks at the sides of the trail as we bring that snow onto the trails to refresh the tracks.
- Dogs must have a current council registration.
- During events, dogs must be on a lead at all times.
- Owners must be able to control their dogs around other dogs.
- Owners must not use foul language when disciplining their dogs.

Snow Farm reserves the right to refuse access to individual dogs and if necessary, revoke purchased tickets if owners are unable to follow the above conditions of use.

Snow Farm reserves the right to exclude all dogs from the trails on certain days in the case of major events or poor snow conditions.
